## **Executive Summary**

In response to the request from the Department of Environment, Heritage, and Local Government, this document seeks to highlight a brief synopsis of feedback from the audit undertaken by Monaghan County Council of Community, Sports and Arts facilities in the county.

In total, questionnaires were successfully completed by 154 organisations, comprising of 84 with a community focus, 67 from a sporting background and a further 3 from an Arts perspective. It is important to bear in mind that numerous facilities will have a dual function so for example some may be given as a sporting facility but may also cater for dancing or cooking classes. Attached in Annex 1 is a complete list of all respondents that took part.

Facilities were found to be well spread throughout both urban and rural areas in the county, with a good mix of activities being provided by community, sports and arts. It was also the case that community facilities tended to be less well equipped in terms of amenities such as toilets or food provision or indeed disabled access. Just under two thirds of all facilities have undertaken refurbishments in recent years, with mostly remedial/structural works being carried out. In terms of past funding, Lottery came out on top, having supported mostly sports facilities, Peace 11 funding was second having supported more community facilities and then to a lesser extent, the CDF (Community Development Fund, MCC). The vast majority of facilities did undertake private fundraising and/or put their own money into refurbishment works. Over half the respondents intend to carry out work in the next 3 years with community facilities putting a focus on basic requirements such as toilets and kitchens, while sporting facilities put more of an emphasis on changing rooms and extensions. The vast majority of facilities indicated that they were in a "pre planning stage". In terms of current standards, 32 facilities indicated that they were in need of repair, and a further 13 were considered to be in significant need of repair, mainly from the community sample, and all of whom are listed in annex 3.

## **Methodology**

The approach taken for this Audit was to conduct surveys with all Community, Arts and Sports facilities in the county, or as near to that as possible. The survey itself was tailored individually according to the facilities purpose, the template's for which were laid out by the Department of Environment, Heritage, and Local Government, and later supplemented by Monaghan County Council. The information gathered and submitted to the department and subsequent analysis has been carried out for the purposes of Monaghan County Council.

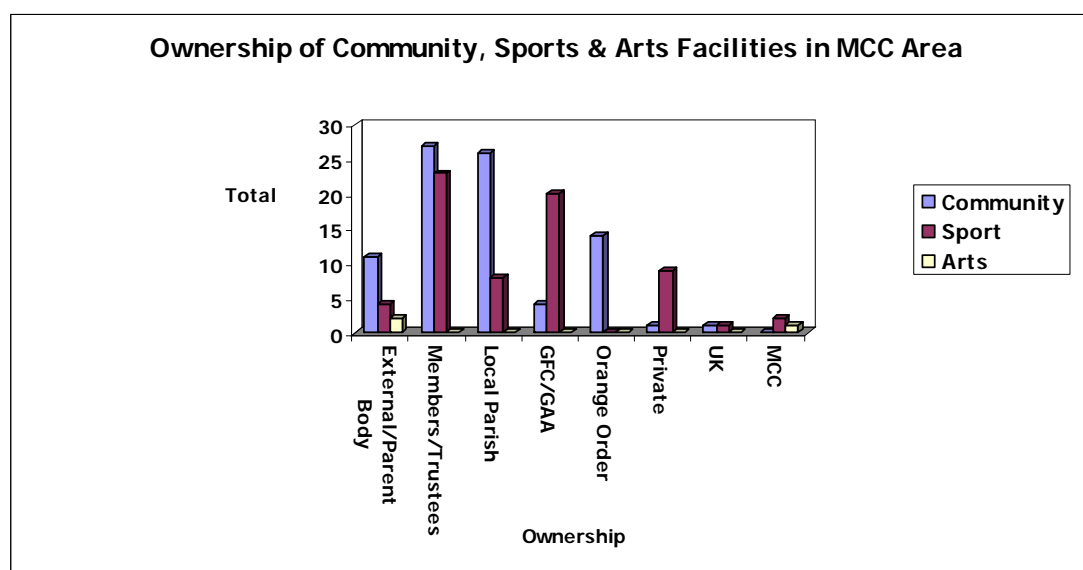
## **Report Constraints**

Whilst all attempts were made to make contact with all facilities from a community, sports or arts background, there may be a small minority with whom we have not been able to consult with as part of this research. This however is not thought to have had an adverse impact on the findings of this report.

The accuracy of the results of this analysis is also largely dependant on the quality of the information provided by respondents.



## Ownership



In terms of ownership, it can be seen that from the graph above, the vast majority of facilities in the county (50) are owned by their own members or a board of trustees from within their respective groups. Local Parish's are the second highest in terms of ownership of mainly their own church halls for solely "community" use (26), but also of a share of sporting facilities in the county (8), being used for a variety of pursuits including boxing, Bowls, Gaelic games, etc.

Of the total of 24 facilities with a primary or secondary function of Gaelic games, 22 were owned by the clubs themselves or the GAA governing body, with the remaining 2 owned by the local Parish.

There were a total of 14 facilities owned by the Orange Order within the county, which all perform a purely "Community" based function.

Those with an External or Parent body ownership refers mainly to "Community" orientated facilities such as the Acorn Centre, An Eaglais, Errigal Heritage Centre etc which are owned by a community based development Board or alternatively a public facility such as the Garage Theatre which is owned by the Health Service Executive (HSE).

Those within the Private category of ownership consist of 10 facilities, 9 of which are "Sports" orientated, consisting of several equestrian centres, Rally School Ireland and also a number of the local Hotels.

### National Governing Body affiliated

42 of the total of 154 (27%) have identified that they are affiliated to a national governing body (NGB). All 42 of these facilities came from the "Sports" section of the Audit, with 25 (60%) of these representing Gaelic games. None of the facilities from the "Community" or "Arts" sections of the Audit were affiliated to a NGB.

### Purpose of facility

In term of a facilities purpose, of the 154 who were audited, 56 or 36% had 2 or more functions in terms of usage, including their primary function. Of those 56, 30 of the facilities from the "Community" and "Sports" audits provided access to 4 or more different activities, a selection of those being listed here: -

- GAA
- Basketball
- Table Tennis
- Aerobics
- Martial Arts
- Volleyball
- Bowls
- Boxing
- Soccer
- Tennis
- Community games
- Irish dancing
- Cooking lessons
- Badminton
- Handball
- Squash

Above is a non exhaustive list of activities catered for in the MCC area, with an impressive variety of pursuits being catered for in the county. Activities may alter from time to time as certain facilities can be hired for any number of purposes.

It is interesting to note that of the 84 facilities with a “community” focus, 33 also provided some sort of sports facility. This represents a significant 39% of community facilities, having another activity other than that of their primary function.

### **Toilet and Food providing facilities**

Respondents were asked to provide details of toilet and food providing facilities which they had available to them at present. The responses were as follows: - Yes – 86%, No – 8%, UK (unknown)/Blank – 6%. It is clear then that the vast majority of facilities have on site toilets, however some 13 facilities are known not to have and are listed below: -

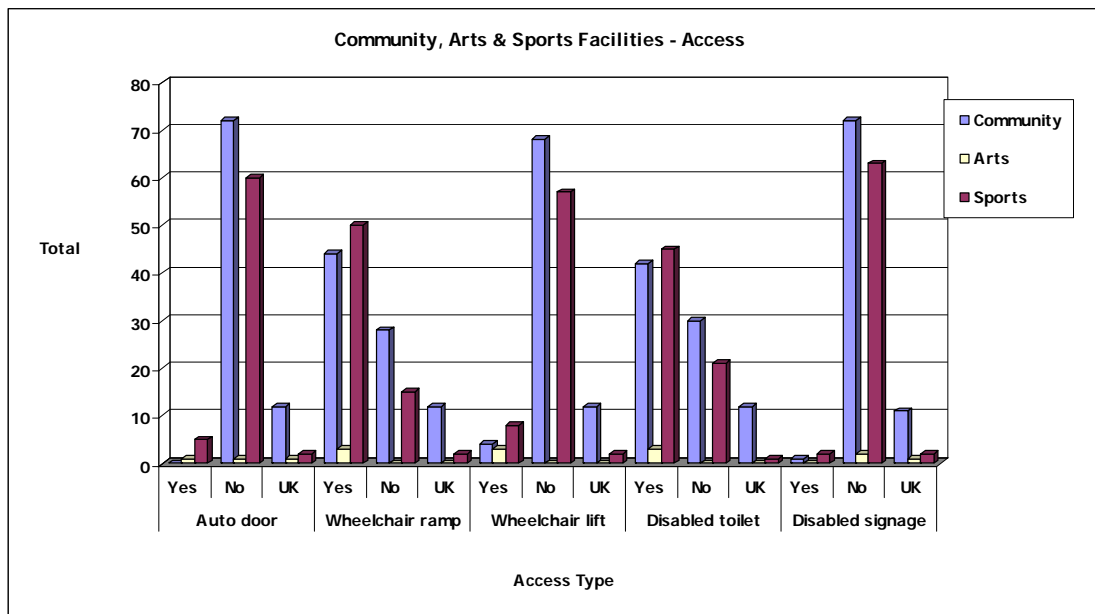
What is striking from this list is that there are 6 Orange Hall's. This may be due to the fact that some of these are very old, usage may be quite low, and for which there may have been a lack of investment over a number of years. This may or may not be the case for the majority in the list above, however the lack of basic amenities such as toilets should be borne in mind.

In terms of food providing facilities, 77% of all respondents indicated that they had access to some sort of facility for providing food (Hot or cold). Of the remaining 27 respondents, 17 had a primary sporting function. This leaves the following 10 facilities from a Community or Arts emphasis: -

- Cahans Church
- Cappagh Hall
- Corragarry Orange Hall
- Corragh Hall
- Emyvale Orange Hall
- Glaslough Orange Hall
- Mullapike Orange Hall
- Patrick Kavanagh Centre

Given that the primary purpose of the facilities above is that of Community and Arts, it is worth noting that food providing facilities; be it a kitchen or simply an area to cater for cold food provision and storage could well be of great benefit to those within the list above.

### Access



All facilities in the council area were audited on accessibility criteria also. As would have been expected, there were only 6 of the total facilities which had an automatic door, including Monaghan Leisure Complex and the Hillgrove Hotel. A similar story was evident in terms of a wheelchair lift, with 15 of the main facilities across the county having such a feature, including the hotels, The Garage Theatre, the Market House, and several of the larger community facilities including the Ballybay Pearse Bros Centre, the Ulster Canal Stores, Clones and also the Iontas Centre from the Arts.

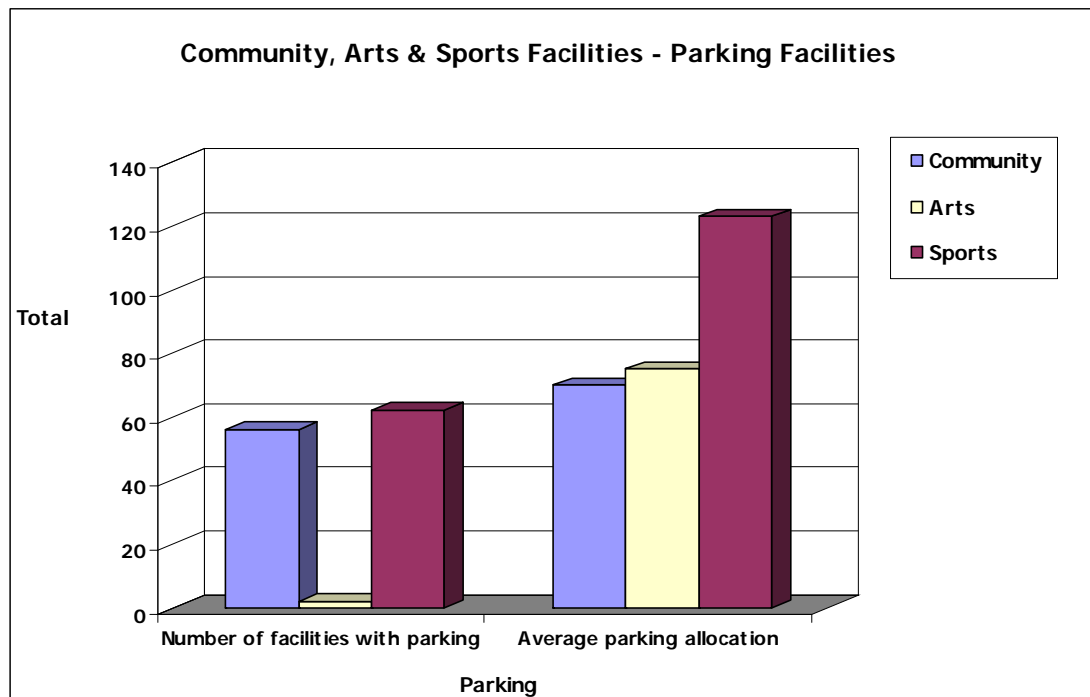
63% of all respondents (97) were found to have a wheelchair ramp, and of the individual classifications in overall terms, 75% of the sports halls, 53% of the community halls, and all three Arts facilities had a wheelchair ramp. The percentage of community halls with a wheelchair ramp is surprisingly low; however this may well be due to the fact that some of these facilities are quite old and would not have been built to these specifications.

58% or 90 of the 154 respondents had disabled toilet facilities on site. This broke down in terms of individual facility types with a disabled toilet, 51% of all community halls, 67% of sports halls and all three Arts facilities in the county.

There were only 3 of all respondents who indicated that they had disabled signage (Braille) within their premises and those were the Hillgrove Hotel, Drumhowan Geraldines GFC and the YWCA.

As most premises would not have the need for either an automatic door or in a large number of cases a wheelchair lift, the remaining facilities in the county who had both a wheelchair ramp and also a disabled toilet, making them for all intents and purposes, relatively accessible, totalled to 83 or 54% of all facilities that were audited. If this is further broke down into the facility types we find that just under half (47%) of all community halls had both these amenities, while 61% of all sports facilities provided both, and all three Arts facilities catered for the disabled in both of the aforementioned ways. So it is evident that sporting facilities in the county are slightly better equipped in terms of accessibility than the community orientated groups. This may well be due to those sporting facilities having had recent money for refurbishment purposes or may have been built in more recent times with those considerations having already been made.

### Parking Allocation



The graph above provides a simple illustration of the number of facilities by classification that have a parking allocation and the also the average number of spaces per facility from that sample. It can be seen that of the 84 community halls audited, 56 (67%) have parking available, and of the 67 sports halls audited, 62 (93%) have parking available, while both the Garage Theatre and the Iontas Centre have parking space from the Arts facilities. It is clear then that the number of community halls without parking is a matter of some concern; however usage levels of some of these may undermine the need for investment in this area.

The average parking allocation is clearly a lot higher for sporting facilities (123) due to higher attendance levels. The average for community halls (70) is reasonable.

There were 18 facilities, 14 of which were community orientated who stated that they did not have parking spaces, and these are listed below: -

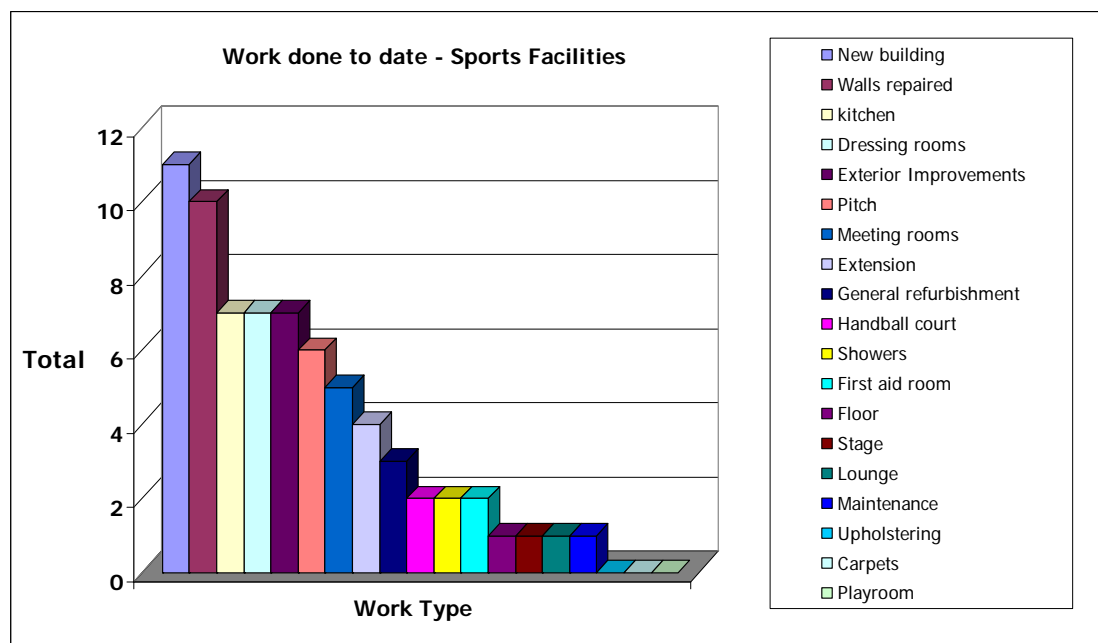

There were also a further 16 facilities for whom no parking information was provided. 10 of these were Orange Halls and the remainder are listed below. It would be fair to say that the majority of these halls would not have an abundance of parking available.

- Valley Pitch & Putt

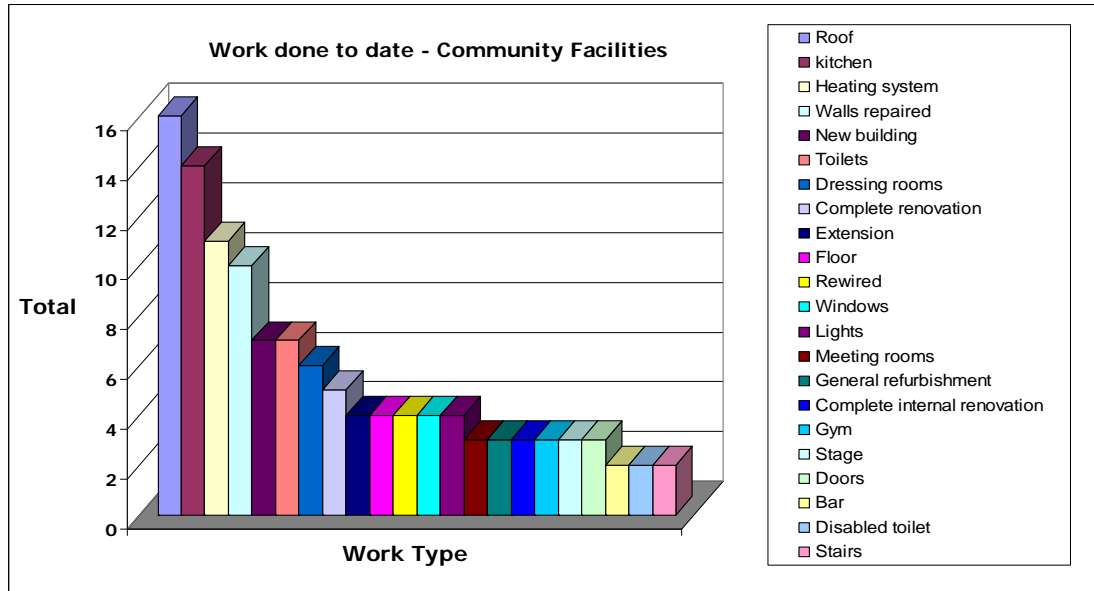
### Recent Refurbishment – Funding Streams

Of the 154 respondents, 99 (64%) indicated that they had carried out refurbishments in recent years. A breakdown of this shows that of those 99, 54 were community orientated, 43 were from sports and 2 from the Arts. The graphs below denote the most popular types of renovation work carried out by the community and sports facilities.



From a sports perspective, the top 5 most popular types of work carried out have been as follows: -

- New building
- Walls repaired (interior and exterior)
- New Kitchens
- New Dressing rooms/changing facilities
- Exterior Improvements (fencing, re surfacing, drainage etc).



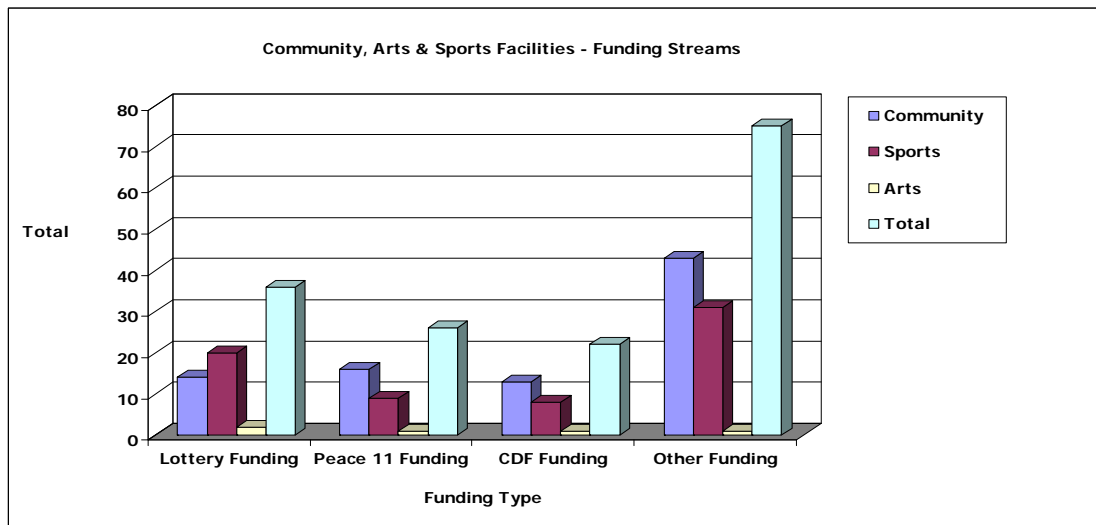
In terms of community halls, the top 5 most popular types of work carried out have been as follows: -

- New roofs
- New kitchen facilities
- New heating systems
- Walls repaired (interior and exterior)
- New building

It can be seen then that money has been targeted towards remedial/structural works and/or essential amenities concerned with the day to day running of local facilities, both community and sports orientated.

## Funding

As far as funding for any work that has been previously done by facilities in the county, the following graph provides a breakdown of sources of finance received.

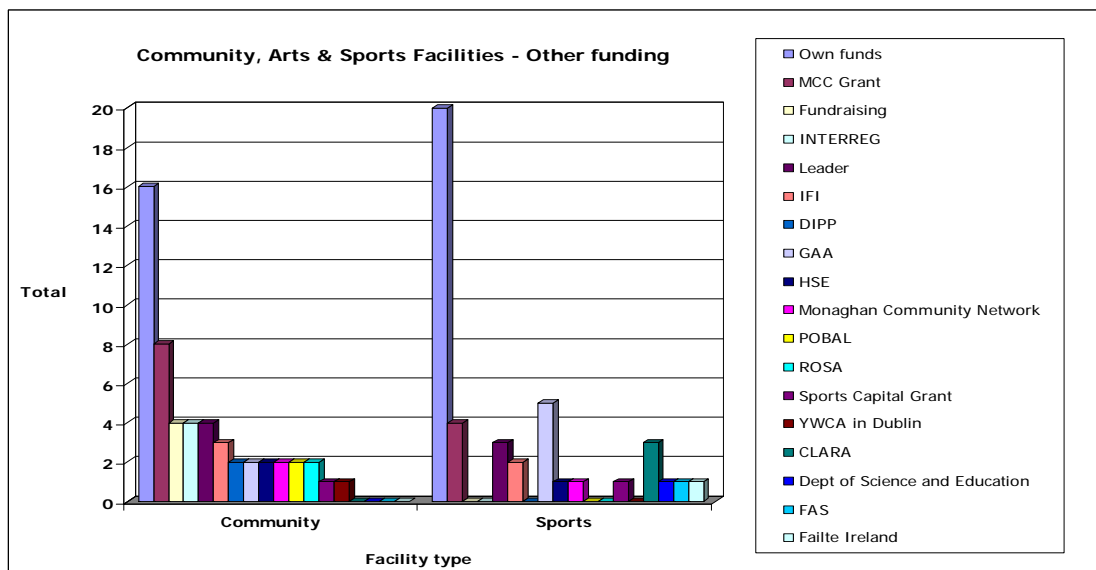


In terms of the spread of funding for community, arts and sports facilities, the majority of funding came from sources other than those highlighted by the survey which were the National Lottery, Peace 11 and the CDF (Community Development Fund). Within those three groups, the National Lottery supported the most facilities within the county (36), with Sports facilities being favoured slightly (20 facilities compared to 15 community facilities). From the Arts, The Garage Theatre was funded by the National Lottery and the Iontas Centre received financial assistance from all three main funds in the graph above.

Peace 11 money was directed more towards community orientated facilities in the county (16) with a total of 26 groups receiving funding from this source.

The CDF fund provided money to 22 groups within the county, with community orientated facilities being favoured slightly (14).

A breakdown of other sources of funding is shown in the graph below.

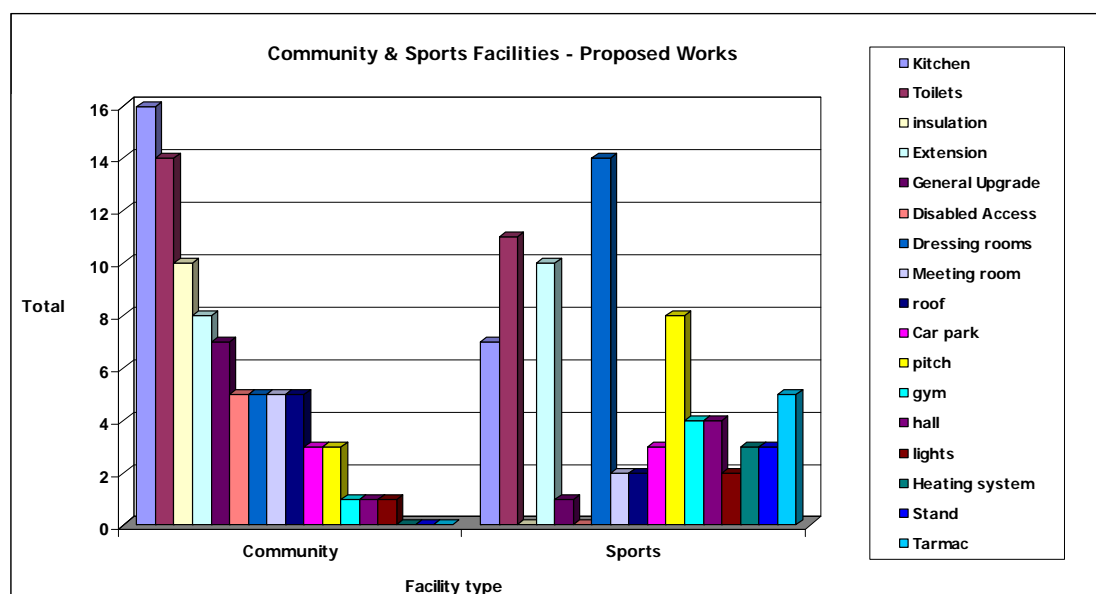


There were a total of 68 separate community facilities that accumulated funding from other sources compared to 43 sports facilities. It can be seen quite clearly that the vast majority of other sources of funding comes from within the groups themselves in terms of fundraising or membership contributions etc.

Other sources of funding that were consistent across both types of halls were grants from Monaghan County Council, Leader, and Interreg. The GAA provided 5 of the sports facilities with grants also.

## Future Plans

90 (58%) of the original 154 respondents indicated that they intended to develop their facilities within the next 3 years, with 50 being community based, 39 from a sporting background and one from the Arts.

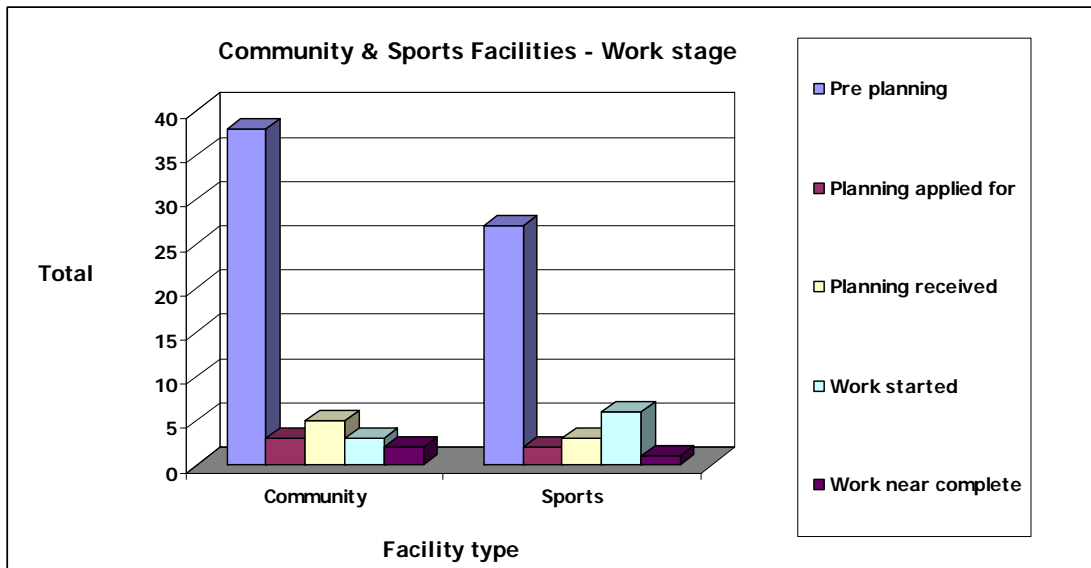


From the graph above it could be said that the main priority for community halls would be new kitchen and toilet facilities (30 combined), and the same would be priorities for sports halls also (18 combined).

Insulation (dry lined walls or repairs to wall structure), extensions and general upgrades also feature quite heavily amongst the community samples priorities (25 combined), where as with the sports sample it is extensions which are being planned for mainly (10).

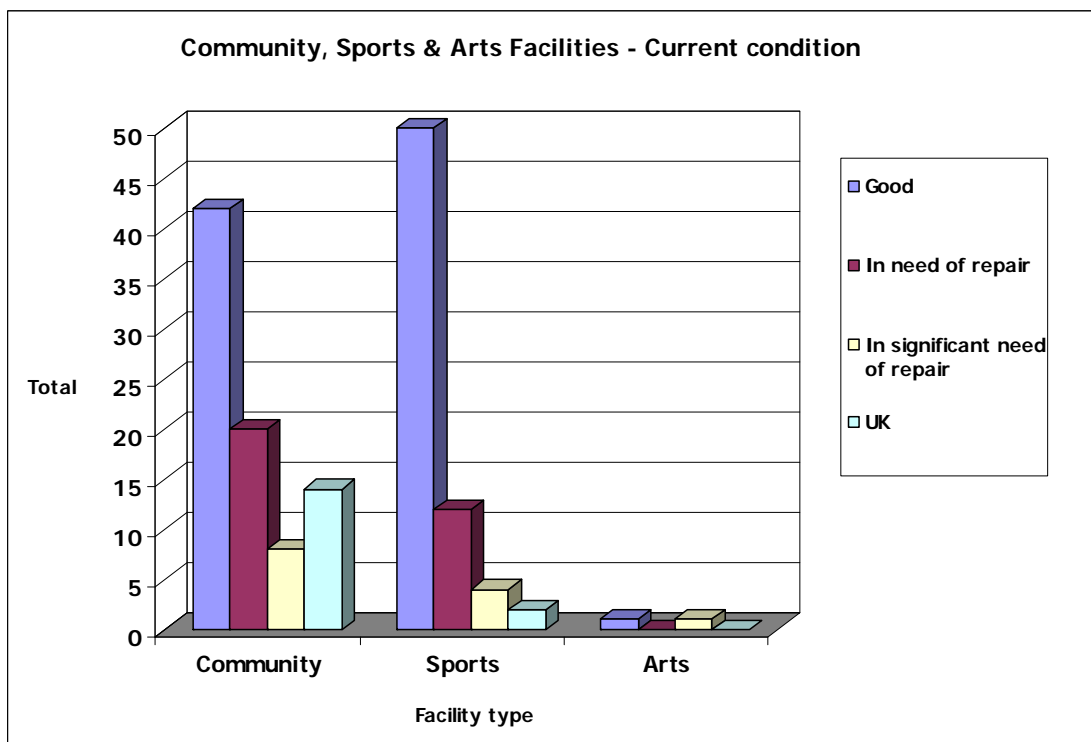
The main priority for sporting facilities though is for dressing/changing facilities (14), either new or upgrades as well as improvements to pitches (grass and all weather) to a certain extent (8).

From the Arts sample, the Lontas Centre intended to build an extension, which is now nearly complete.



The graph above shows what stage facilities are at with their proposed development over the incoming years. It is clear that the vast majority are still at a “pre planning” stage, within both the community and sports areas, and so therein lies the prospect of a significant financial requirement in terms of funding streams in the near future. A list has been included in annex 2 of all those as detailed in the graph above for future reference.

All respondents were asked to best describe their facility in terms of its current standard, with the following graph outlining the outcomes.



It is clear that the vast majority of facilities were said to be in a “Good” condition. What is also clear is that there are significant numbers who fall into the “In need of repair” and “In significant need of repair” categories. There were 8 facilities from the community sector which fall into the latter category, 4 from Sports and 1 from the Arts, which are listed below:

## Signage

Respondents were asked if their facility was signposted from the road and also if there was clear signage at the facility itself. 41 (27%) indicated that their facility was signposted from the road, while 63 (41%) indicated that they had signage at their facility. It may well be an issue of whether or not signage is appropriate for some of the community groups, however the percentages with either signage at their facility or signage directing people to them remains relatively low.
